Intent

Implementation

In order for children to develop upon their prior understanding and implement skills they develop , Global Learning needs to be :

- Delivered a minimum of once a topic (half term).
- Recognised when being discussed/ learnt.
- Delivered with high expectations.
- Tasks are interesting,stimulating and engaging to all abilities.
- Cross- curricular activities developing recognised skills of a Global Learner.
- Create exciting and stimulating “Team Days” which include aspects of cultural aspects and global issues.

Impact

- Enable children to understand and explore current global affairs and their impact on the local and wider community.
- Provide enriched opportunities for where teaching and learning can involve outside expert knowledge.
- Create an atmosphere of cultural appreciation.
- Promote children’s understanding of their own impact on their local and wider community.
