



## Climate

Children to compare the North and South Pole weather.

Use a thermometer in a bucket of ice and see how cold it is. Is it colder than the North and South Pole. Arctic is 4 times colder than your freezer!

Children to investigate the weather in the Sahara Desert and compare to Weymouth.

## Environment

Compare habitats in the North and South Pole to the desert.

Children to create tuft trays to represent the different species of animals.

Children to understand weather they can live in polar regions and deserts.

Children to investigate habitats you would find in Weymouth and make comparisons to other regions of the world.

## Disaster

Children to understand Climate Change and how the ice caps are melting.

Discuss how the Earth is warming up and the North and South Poles are becoming smaller.

## Location

Children to locate North and South Pole using compass directions north and south. Antarctic and Arctic.

Children to locate the Sahara Desert on a map and discuss the invisible line called the equator.

Investigate the Inuit culture also known as Eskimos. Discuss the differences and similarities of how they live, what they wear in order to survive. Comparison to Weymouth and what we wear.
