

## Empire

Children to discuss what is an empire. Using role play. Compare with families. Who did the family start with and how has it grown?

## Trade

What does trade mean?  
Explore by swapping items and exchanging money.

Role play shop with old and new items/pictures.

Discuss what makes things valuable e.g valuable to them or the materials used.

## Monarchy

Use images to compare the lives of Queen Elizabeth II and King Charles III

Create a basic family tree of the Royal Family.

As a class write a letter to the King coming up with questions together.

## Democracy

Use class charter and school council to discuss what democracy - rules made by everyone.

Who is the Prime Minister and what is their job? Role play electing a class PM and making and following rules.

## Settlement

What is a settlement? Look at different places in Weymouth. LOTC - walk in the local area and discuss whether they are old or new. How do you know?

Children to look at the cinema compared with the Tudor House. Which one is older, how do you know?

## Significant people and events

Place significant events of their own life and recent history on a timeline.

Children to create questions and interview a grandparent in school.

Children to compare their own lives with the life of a grandparent. Use images to support like images of clothes, schooling.
