



## Are you eligible for Free School Meals?

I registered for Pupil Premium while I was on maternity leave for a period of 6 months, I was still classed as employed but on a low income so met the criteria for the support for my other child who attended primary school.

At the time, I thought this would just be support with free school dinners however, I later discovered that it offered much more. It not only offered support for the time I was on maternity, but some of the elements of the support continues until they leave school; these included contributions towards school uniform, discounted educational school trips and revision books once in senior school. The revision books were a great help as these were on average £10 a book.

If you think you would be eligible for free school dinners or are not sure. I would strongly recommend anybody to discuss with the school, and apply, even if your child is in reception, year 1 or 2 and already getting a free school meal.
