Children to infer what they think a Viking longship was used for and understand the significance of travel by sea and routes taken.

Explore aspects of invade, raid and trade

Monarchy

Allow children to decipher why they believe King Alfred was called Alfred the Great - use different sources such as portraits and known facts to support.

Empire

Gain an understanding of just how far and wide the Vikings travelled and settled

Democracy

Understand the Treaty of peace between Anglo Saxons and Vikings and establishment of Danelaw.

Learn about Viking rules and role play a trial and decide as a class the outcome of breaking Viking laws.

Settlement

Children to understand the reasons why the Vikings invaded Britain.

Investigate why Lindisfarne is significant and identify places in Britain named after the vikings.

Significant people and events

Children to look at the events of 1066 using different sources like the Bayeux tapestry. Children to analyse and interpret what they think is happening.
